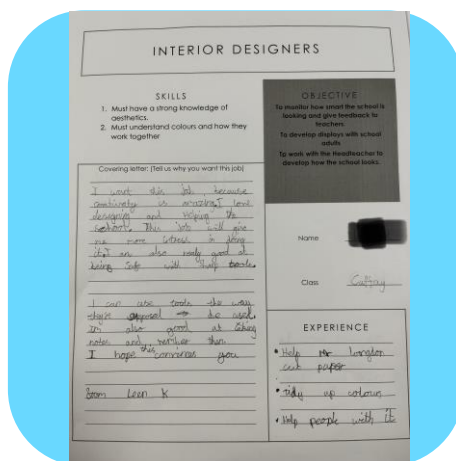


The Meadows Library
