Ofsted Inspection

Last week saw our first inspection since the school re-opened as Victoria Primary School nearly three years ago. This was something that school staff have been waiting for since February so we were happy the inspectors finally arrived! The inspectors have sent their evidence and their draft report back to Ofsted and we are expecting the grade and report to be back with us before the end of the term. As soon as we have it – we will let you have it too!

Year 5 & 6 Show Dates

We are sorry for the changes to show dates which have happened. We had planned around the city-wide transition days, however some non-city schools have different dates which would have meant some Year 6 children missing out on their own show. Staff illness last week now means that children aren't quite ready so the new dates are:

- 2pm on Friday 5th July
- 4pm on Monday 8th July

These performances don't have tickets – families are welcome to attend whichever performance suits them best.

Transition Days – Wednesday and Thursday this week

Year 6 children who are moving on to city secondary schools will attend their new schools on Wednesday and Thursday.

Everyone else will come to their normal classes on Wednesday morning then meet their new teachers after morning assembly.

On Wednesday afternoon, Thursday morning and Thursday afternoon, families will need to collect / drop-off at different classrooms to normal. Mr Gray, Mrs Brook and Miss Froggatt will be out to help direct you – just ask and we'll point you in the right direction.

A word of warning...

The classrooms children go to on Transition Days might not be the classrooms they are in when we come back in September. Nursery, Years 1, 2 and 3 will all be swapping around to give classrooms that are better suited to children's sizes and space needs. More on this before the end of term.
