Coronavirus – What to do

The government says that people should stay at home for 14 days if they or anyone in their house have either:

- a high temperature (they feel hot to touch on their chest or back)
- a new, continuous cough – this means they have started coughing repeatedly

If anyone has one of these symptoms, everyone in the house should:

- Stay at home for 14 days
- Do not go to a GP surgery, pharmacy or hospital.
- You do not need to contact 111 to tell them you're staying at home.
- Testing for coronavirus is not needed if you're staying at home.

Only children who are healthy and from symptom-free houses should come to school. If you have any health concerns for your child, please leave a message (option 1 on our school phone system) so that we can authorise your child's absence.

Home Learning Packs

Teachers are preparing packs of work for children to complete if they are off school or if school is closed. These are not optional – children are expected to complete work and families are very welcome to threaten detentions on return to school if children want to argue! We will follow through with this to support families. Packs will be ready by Thursday.
