Pupils: School safety rules



No school if there are ANY symptoms in your home.



Bring your own full water-bottle each day.



Be on time



Obey the special signs and markings around school. Doing this will keep all families safe.



Follow instructions given by your school adult.



Stay 2m away from your school adult.



Follow our hygiene expectations.



Use a tissue when you sneeze



Remember not to touch each other.



Talk to us if you are feeling worried about something.

How we are keeping you safe in school

Your class will be your bubble.

Your class will not mix with children from any other class at all during school hours. This means that if there is an infection in one class, all other classes are protected.

Your class will have:

- Its own start time
- Its own teacher or teaching assistant
- Its own handwashing facilities and hand sanitizer
- Its own break time
- Its own lunch time
- Its own home time

In your bubble you should:

- Stay in your own learning space
- Only use the books, stationery and resources you have been given
- Wash your hands as soon as you re-enter the classroom
- Wash your hands after you have been to the toilet or outside to play/exercise
- Have your own 'bubble' break-times, in the area allocated to you

The adult in your bubble will:

- Answer any questions you have
- Reassure you if you have worries
- Provide you with appropriate learning activities and resources
- Remind you about strategies for staying safe and healthy
- Make sure your bubble is cleaned regularly
