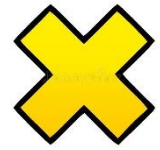
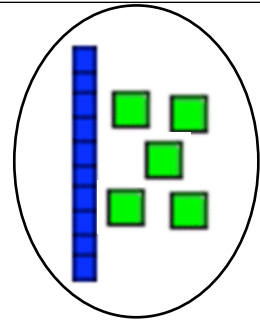
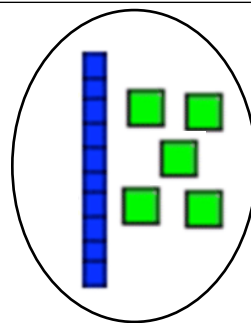
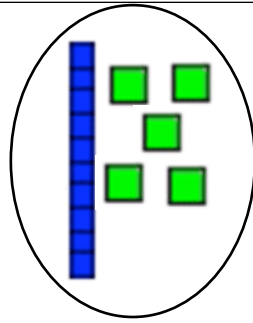


# Multiplication



In Year 3, children should apply their times table knowledge to multiply a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number.

$15 \times 3$

x	10	5
3	30	15
<b>30 + 15 = 45</b>

Now you are ready to use the short multiplication method!

Always multiply the ones first (3 x 5)

Remember to carry the 1 ten underneath the tens column.

Multiply the tens digit (3 x 1)

Remember to add on the 1 ten (3 + 1)
