Homework

Continuing on from the booklets that were handed out last half-term, the children will receive a new homework book. Please encourage the children to complete these and return them every Monday morning. Don't forget to keep on reading at least 3 times a week, learning times tables and practise vocabulary spellings.

English

Our English will be based on the topic of 'Deadly 60'. As well as developing, describing and detailing our own deadly animals, we will be reading the book 'Akimbo and the Snakes' as inspiration. Our grammar focus will be on adverbs, prepositions and speech, with the ultimate aim of tying all of these things together to write our own 'Deadly 60' inspired stories and information texts.

Maths

The children will continue to apply their year 4 knowledge to reason and solve problems in maths. The topics we will be covering this half term are Place Value, Statistics, Fractions, Decimals and Geometry. The children in year 4 have been doing a weekly times table test where they are given 6 seconds per question. We are noticing a definite improvement over time and this is due to the regular practice of times tables. It is important that the children are given as many opportunities to practise their times tables at home, as they are crucial to all areas of maths. Thank you for your support in this area.

Science

The children are looking forward to learning about animals and their habitats. We will be doing a nature walk and sketching in our Art books any animals that we encounter!

Linked to our science topic, we have planned a trip to the Zoo in July. More information about this trip will be sent out soon.

Swimming

The children who carried on swimming last half term will continue to go swimming this half term unless a teacher tells you otherwise.
